

## 2007 SHHS Band Booster Concessions

### Overview:

Concessions is our **largest fundraiser that does not involve the help of the band students**. We expect to raise about \$15,000 in funds this year for the general band-booster fund, which benefits all band students.

This fundraiser **requires** the support of **more boosters than any other project we undertake**. Each booster member, excluding those in field crew and hospitality duties during the games, is expected to sign up for one varsity-game concessions shift. If each booster signs up for one shift, then we should have more than enough to cover all the games.

\* We prefer not to schedule parents of seniors the final game, because they have activities with their students on the field during this game.

### How it Works:

Each varsity game requires about 25 workers to cover the two concession stands. This year there will be 2 shifts 5:00 (or as close as you can get) until 8:30 and 6:00 until close (about 9:30). The early shift will setup and start preparing hot dogs and work through half time; the 6:00 shift will work selling during the game and clean up (most of which is done during 4th quarter).

For non-varsity games, only the small concession stand is used, requiring much fewer workers. However, there are many more non-varsity games (about 12).

### Meet the Chairs:

Our Concessions chairs are **Cuddy Austin** and **Lisa Boghonian**. They have planned for many months, are well prepared, and will have everything ready so things will run smoothly when you get there. Do not worry if you have never worked concessions before; Lisa and Cuddy will welcome you with open arms and will train you for your task so that you are comfortable.

### How to Sign Up / Message from the Chairs:

Pick a date and shift that works for you and email this information to us (Cuddy or Lisa). If you have a preference of large or small concession stand, let us know; we will do our best to accommodate. We are hoping to have a great season and a good time so do not miss out on the fun.
