

***How to care for the marching band uniforms
and keep their value high for resale...
and help your student to look great on the field***

Uniforms need to be washed before the first game.

- Wash uniform weekly
- Do NOT dry clean
- Use cold/cool water
- Use “Shout Color catcher” to minimize dirt on white fabric
- May use fabric softener
- Tumble uniform 5 min., then hang to dry
- For stains try:
 - grandma’s stain remover
 - shout
 - tide pen
 - dawn dishwashing liquid
- Do NOT walk in the hem of the bib pants (don’t take the straps off the shoulders) which puts a hole in the hem line.
- Gloves may need to be washed after a few uses.

Just a reminder, students need to have black socks (at least mid-calf height) for their uniforms. If your student is missing their gloves, we will have them sign out a used pair for the game or contest. If they do not return them that night there will be a \$3.00 charge on their charms account (remember they are used and may not be your students correct size). If the tuba players lose their beret, there will be a \$6.00 charge. Wipe off black shoes each week.
